The fourth Central Park Music Festival, presented by the F. and M. Schaefer Brewing Company, will open June 26 with Benny Goodman and Lionel Hampton. Mr. Goodman will have a 17-piece orchestra, his largest group in recent years.

Ron Delsener, festival producer, will present 33 concerts this summer. There will be two performances each evening; admission is \$1 and \$1.50.
